

## **COVID-19 SUMMER CAMP PROTOCOL**

The following regulations are being put in place in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and in compliance with the orders set by the state of Virginia. These protocols are subject to change at any point if indicated by Governor Northam and will be strictly followed to ensure the health and safety of our campers and their families.

We ask that all parents please read these regulations thoroughly, and have the appropriate conversation with their child. We will be doing the majority of camp outside, but will split up groups if we need to be inside. Snacks will be served inside or on the outside patio of the JBC.

## What your camper should expect from summer camp:

- 1) Please dress your camper for an outdoor experience depending on the weather each day. We will split the group up to go inside to our dance studio and theatre in case of rain and extreme heat.
- 2) Campers are encouraged to bring their own reusable water bottles, sunscreen (applied at home before camp each day), hats, and other necessities. Campers will not be permitted to share any of these items with other campers as so to prevent the spreading of germs.
- 3) Campers are required to wear close-toed shoes with the exception of costume pieces. Sneakers are recommended.
- 4) The June Bug will provide access to water through a water cooler each day at camp for students to be able to refill their water bottle throughout the day.
- 5) All campers are required to wear a face mask with them each day of camp. We will have camp themed masks available to campers who need them. These masks can be washed after every use and will have a pocket to put filters in. To ensure the cleanliness of all surfaces, play areas, LEGOS, theatre props, etc. June Bug staff will conduct proper sanitation at the end of each camp day and throughout the camp day as needed. Each camper will have their own bag of LEGOS or props to ensure no sharing of germs throughout the camp day.

## **DROP-OFF & PICK-UP**

- 1) Drop-off and pick-up will take place in front of the main building. Please pull up to an available parking space closest to the front entrance.
- 2) Upon arrival, each student will apply hand sanitizer provided by the JBC.



- 3) Drop-off: Parents are asked to wait in their car with their student. Upon arrival, one of the JBC staff members will come to each car to bring your student to their assigned "home base" each morning.
- 4) Pick-up: Parents are asked to wait in their car. Upon arrival, one of the JBC staff members will bring each student to their prospective parent/ car.
- 5) If you need to get a hold of your camper at any time throughout the day, or drop something off to them, please call the JBC office at 540-745-6550.

If your child is sick, please keep them home from camp. We kindly ask you to take your campers temperature before the start of each camp day. If a camper has a fever, they will not be allowed on site, and we ask that you keep them home for a minimum of 24 hours after the fever has subsided. If you have been exposed to COVID-19, it is essential that you notify us immediately, and we ask that you please do not attend camp.
